(SD,K,F – *A.. cingulata*) [Northern and western; stable mud]
Emergent notoacicula straight *Glyphohesione klatti* Friedrich, 1950
(SD,K,P,H =*Synelmis*) [Widespread ?; stable mud]
4. Median antenna present *Otopsis longipes* Ditlevsen, 1917
(D) [Arctic]
Median antenna absent *Pilargis verrucosa* Saint-Joseph, de, 1899
(SD,K,F) [Southern]
